

## Problemas nos caracteres acentuados

Após a instalação do biblio.NET pode ser necessário executar os procedimentos de importação de registos. Durante este processo são integrados na base de dados os registos e criados vários passos de transformação de caracteres. Nalgumas situações, os caracteres acentuados podem não ser visualizados correctamente. Este problema depende das configurações regionais do servidor. Os passos que se seguem devem ser executados antes da conversão.
